English



The children will be exploring these texts; developing their skills for retelling, using expanded noun phrases, adverbial phrases and commas to mark clauses.

History



In History, we will be looking at the impact of World War II on the people of Britain and Stockport. The children will develop their skills for analysing and interpreting sources of evidence, as well as exploring cause and consequence with WWII.

Foundation Subjects

French



In French, the children will be learning all about describing themselves and how they feel.

Maths

We will also be focusing on mental arithmetic!

The children will be exploring the nature of God's call to love others. Children will study and reflect imaginatively on the story of Zacchaeus' conversion, exploring ways they can hear God's call in their lives.
We will also explore personal relationships and equip children with strategies to manage conflict, responding to pressure and how our thoughts and feelings impact how we act.

The children will explore songs of WWII and develop their understanding of the impact music can have.
