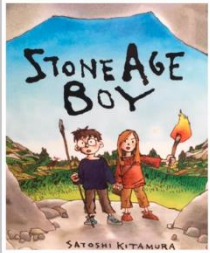




Year 3/4 Newsletter - Spring 1

English

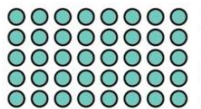


We are looking at the book Stone Age Boy. The children will continue to develop their writing skills, retelling the story and using speech to show the relationship between the characters.

Maths

There are 5 equal groups of 8.

Science



This half term we are looking at living things and their habitats. Children will be learning about classifying animals based on their characteristics.

History



Our topic this half term is 'Were the Vikings invaders or peace living settlers?' The children will develop their understanding of chronology and change between periods of time. We will make links to our previous topic of Anglo-Saxons.

Our focus this half term is the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We will reflect on what it means to say sorry and forgive.
