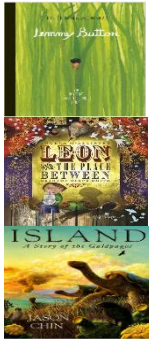




Year 6 Newsletter, Spring 2

Religion & Celebration of the Word

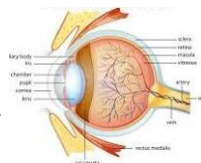


Jesus the Messiah
